GVPT Quantitative Methods Courses

GVPT B.S students must complete 2 GVPT Quantitative Methods Courses (6 credits) at the 300/400 level. IR B.S. students must complete 1 GVPT International Relations/Comparative Politics (IR/CP) Quantitative Methods Course (3 credits) at the 300/400 level and 1 GVPT Quantitative Methods Course (3 credits) at the 300/400 level. GVPT courses used to satisfy these requirements may not also fulfill other major requirements, such as courses of choice.

Many of these courses have prerequisites and other restrictions. It is the student's responsibility to proactively review course descriptions to confirm courses they register for are not duplicates of courses they have already completed.
